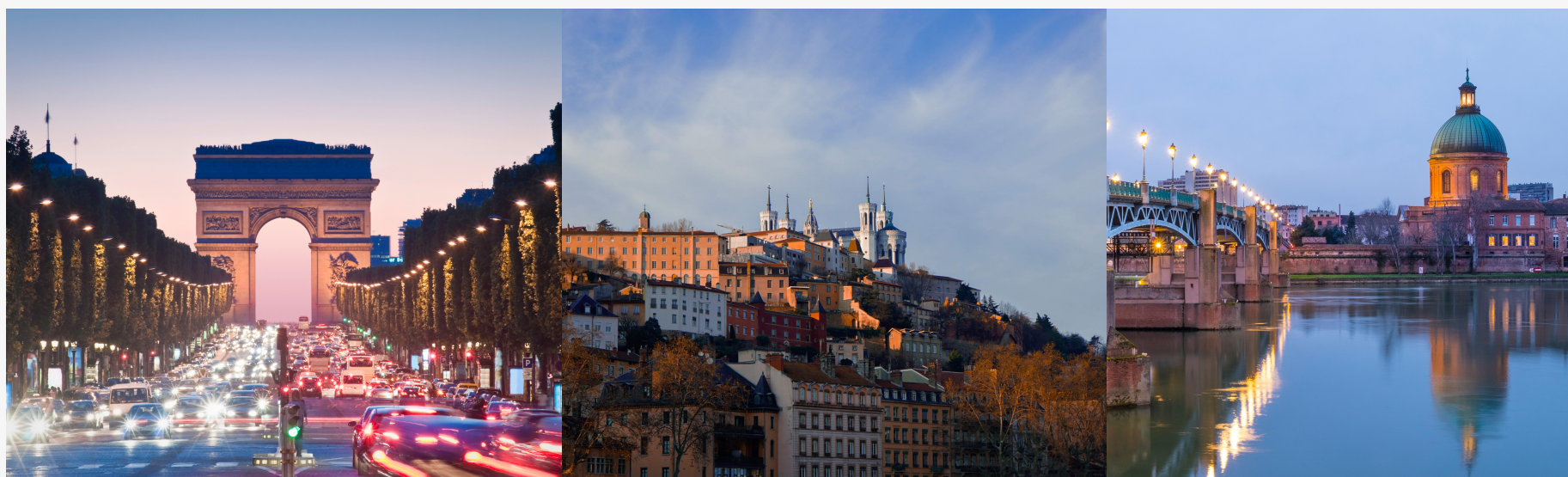

COSTS OF STUDYING IN FRANCE

The most apparent advantage of studying in the FRANCE is the lesser duration of the programs: 3yrs for an UG degree and only 1 year for a Masters degree. This means lesser expenses than other destinations (like the US, CANADA, AUSTRALIA)

TYPES OF ACCOMMODATION

University Residences: Located on campus or in town, run by CROUS (Centre Reginaux des Oeuvres Universities et Sociale) these rooms are equipped with all the necessary facilities and the rent is around 250 to 400 Euros.

Private Student Residences: They are found in most of the major cities in France and this concept has been trending lately. Rent around 800-1000 Euros in Paris and 500-800 Euros in other cities. It is less common for students to share flats in France. Landlords often ask for a guarantor.

FRANCE VISA

France has a very simple procedure of Student Visas. Students need to submit their visa documents through online applications for Visa with Campus France. Interview will be taken by Campus France and the documents will be submitted to the Consulate and then the visa is granted.



WORK PERMIT

Working in France during your studies:

- International students are entitled to work part time upto 20 hours a week off campus. In France there is a guaranteed minimum salary which is € 9.61 per hour.

Working in France after your studies

- Students who have earned, at least, a Master's Degree or the equivalent may apply for a one-time (nonrenewable) Temporary Residency Authorization (APS, autorisation provisoire de séjour) valid for 12 months beyond the date of expiration of the student's residency permit. The authorization enables the student to work at any job up to the limit of 60% of the official work week (that is, just over half-time employment).
- Students who obtain a job related to their academic program at a rate of compensation equal to at least 1.5 times the national minimum wage may enter full-time employment by filing a request for change of status (from student to employee) at their prefecture.
- At the end of your studies, you can also be recruited by a company, even if you are not an EU national.
- If you have an aim to come back to India and start your own career here, then your French degree will allow you to avail a circulation visa to France and Europe for 5 years, which will be extended through your life.

Cuisine: French cuisine consists of the cooking traditions and practices from France. French cuisine developed throughout the centuries influenced by the many surrounding cultures of Spain, Italy, Switzerland, Germany and Belgium, in addition to its own food traditions on the long western coastlines of the Atlantic, the Channel and of course inland.

CLIMATIC AND WEATHER CONDITIONS:

In the East, the climate is continental. Summers are warm, with some thunderstorms, and winters are cold. Temperatures can drop below 0 degrees Celsius and, in the mountains, are frequently accompanied by snow. In the South, the climate is Mediterranean. Summers are hot and winters mild and dry.

SAFETY:

France will be very safe for education as according to the Global Peace Index, France is ranked 60th out of 195 countries in the World.

LANGUAGE:

The national language, French, is the only official language according to the second article of the French Constitution, and its standardized variant is by far the most widely spoken.

Several regional languages are also spoken to varying degrees as a secondary language after French, such as German dialects (Alsatian 1.44%), Celtic languages (Breton 0.61%) and other Gallo-Romance languages (Langues d’Oïl 1.25%, Occitan 1.33%)

A lot of people claim that French people do not speak English and that finding someone speaking decent English in France is mission impossible. Well, like many stereotypes, that's simply not true. According to the Eurobarometer report 2012, 39% of the French population speaks English.
