COSTS OF STUDYING AND LIVING IN THE U.S.A

When calculating the cost of education, living expenses play a critical role. On an average, a student spends approx \$15000 – \$18000/year. But the expenses also depend on the place where a student stays i.e. if a student stays in metropolitan city like New York, San Francisco, Manhattan, etc the expenses could go up to \$20000 / year in comparison to a student studying in a suburban area where the expenses are around \$10000 to \$12000 / year.

ACCOMODATION

Most of the educational institutions will assist you in finding accommodation while studying in the USA. Accommodation are of two types

- Student can stay on campus (Halls of Residence/Students hostel)
- Off Campus (Home stay, Apartments/Flats)

Staying Off Campus is much cheaper as compared to staying On Campus but it is always advisable that a student must stay on campus for the first six months.

U.S.A VISA

PART TIME EMPLOYMENT IN U.S.A

International students can take up campus jobs. They are allowed to work 20 hrs per week during a semester (on campus). On campus jobs may include teaching assistantship or research assistantship where a student is paid \$8 to \$10 per hour. Thus student earns \$500-\$600 per month or can get a waiver in tuition fees. With this, a student can also do an internship in the related field which may be paid. During vacation the student is allowed to work for 40 hrs per week. On completion of the course, the student is allowed to work for 1yr popularly known as OPT (Optional Practical Training). Students with certain degrees in a STEM(Science, Technology, Engineering an Mathematics) field are allowed to work for 36 months. On completion of the their OPT, the student can later apply on a H1B visa (work permit visa) for work.

SCHOLARSHIP

Fee waivers are awarded to international students on the criteria of merit & need. Candidates with strong academics, good performance on standardized exams & extra curricular achievements are eligible for scholarships, awards & financial assistance. To benefit from these opportunities, one has to send all the required documents by particular deadlines. In addition to this, the presentation of the application package is also important because one is judged by the image one projects.

There are various types of Scholarships:

- Fellowship-Scholarship: This is usually offered on the student's ability, competence & performance.
- Assistantship: Generally involves a teaching or research assistantship. Students receive aid, in the form of cash stipend or a tuition fee waiver or reduced tuition fee.
- Sports Scholarship: Though seldom offered to international students, athletic or sports scholarships are available to a wide range of outstanding and talented athletes.
